If you don't have a new Lake Hemet card, please contact [www.aqua-adventures.com](http://www.aqua-adventures.com) to take a rescue class to get your Lake Hemet Safety Card. Gary Hakala will conduct a safety training course in early August for those who wish to participate in the Charity Paddle when he returns from vacation. Call him after August 1<sup>st</sup> (951) 990-1361 or email him at [garyhakala@gmail.com](mailto:garyhakala@gmail.com) to arrange for a class. Your kayak must be a sit-in-side 10' or longer. No sit-on-tops or inflatable kayaks are allowed.

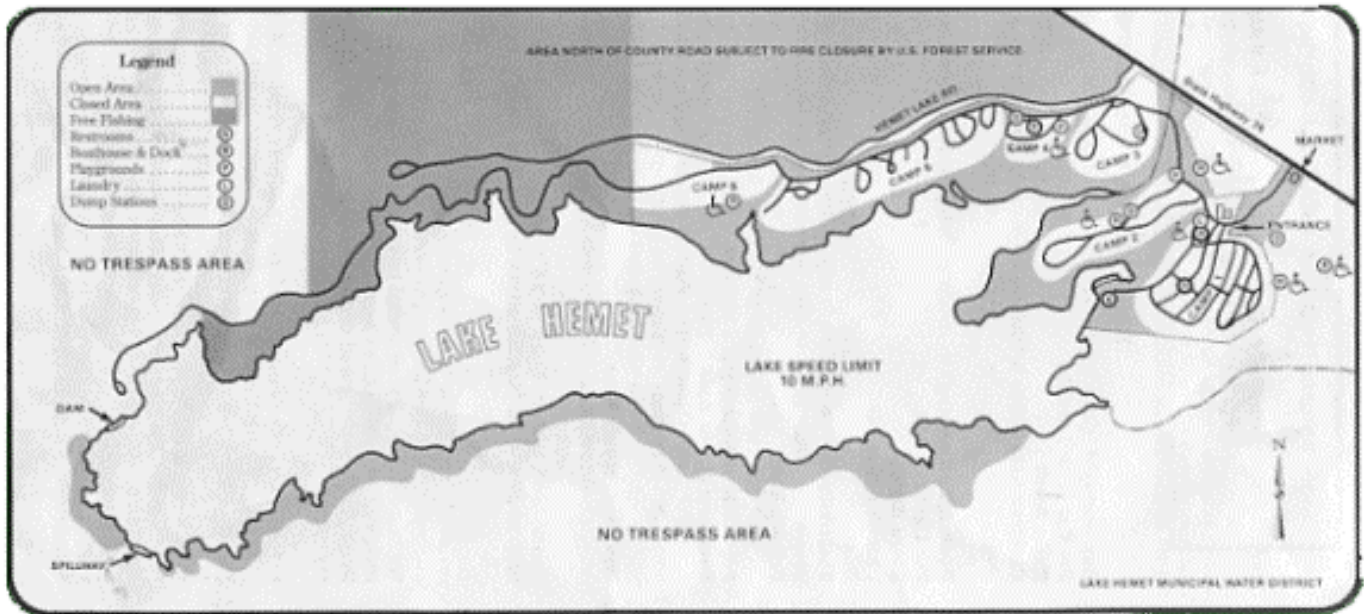
