

ALAMITOS BAY / NAPLES CANAL (LONG BEACH) PADDLE
Saturday, September 25, 2010 7:30 a.m.



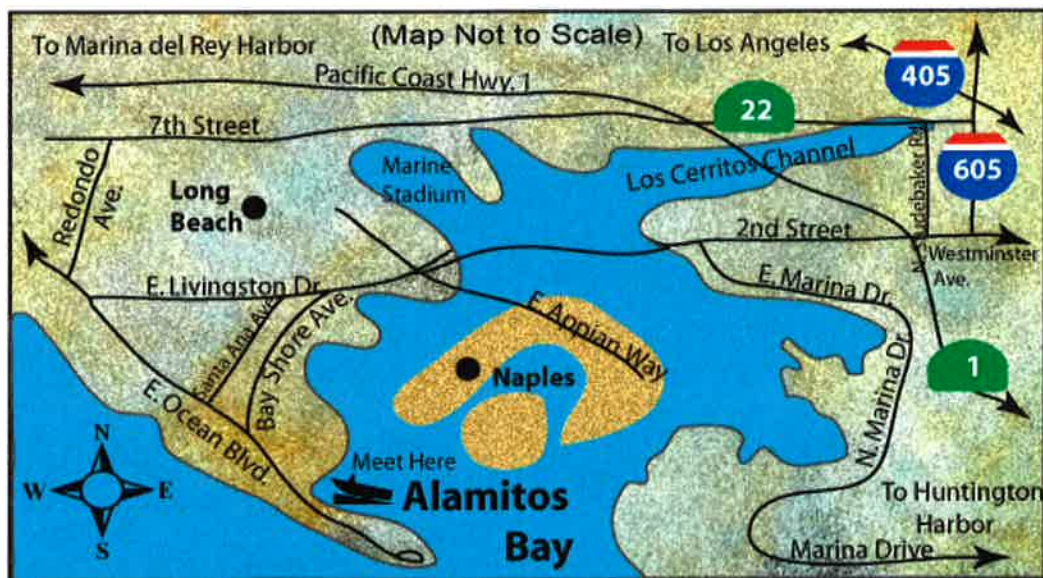
DIRECTIONS: (See Map on back) Westminster Avenue turns into 2nd street. Go over two bridges and turn **left** on Bay Shore Avenue Drive then veer to the **left** when the road forks (54th Place) and turn **left** onto Ocean Boulevard. The kayak launch area is about one-hundred feet down on the left. [Best to use map-quest for freeway directions from your home – Bay Shore Ave. & E. Ocean Blvd, Long Beach, CA 90803]

NOTE: Bay Shore Avenue may still be closed for the summer, so you may have to take a side street to E. Ocean Blvd. We will launch our boats first and then try to find parking. The earlier we get there the better.

LAUNCH: The boat launch is next to the Gondola rentals about 100 feet from 54th Place and Ocean Blvd.

PARKING is limited along Ocean Blvd. If you get there early around **7:00 am you may get free parking**. Otherwise, you will need to drop off your kayak and park in a **metered** space along Ocean and walk back (bring change). Sit-on-top kayak rentals are available. There is a small snack shack near the launch area for lunch.

TOUR: We will kayak through Naples Canals first then go under the 2nd Street bridge cross Marine Stadium and tour some other boat harbors. This is an easy paddle and very relaxed. Those who want more action can head out to the ocean.
